After going through our inventory of ink, we have discovered numerous short-dated or slightly expired inks. Keep in mind that manufacturer's expiry dates are generally quite generous. I have seen inks that were several years past their date, and they still worked just fine. What we have on sale are inks that either expire in the next few months (10% off) or inks that expired earlier this year (so only a few months out of date) at 20% off.

Nikon D800 Lens Notes

As some of you may have heard, I recently purchased a Nikon D800 system for myself. The dynamic range and resolution benefits at its price point were just too compelling for me to resist

for the type of photography that I do, namely landscape and cityscape work these days. I have now done some extensive lens tests with the D800 and believe I can make some good recommendations as far as the best lenses to use for superb resolution and sharpness across the full frame. As a rough rule of thumb, you could say that any of the higher end full-frame AF-S 'G' lenses that have been introduced in the last few years are safe bets, with some of the newest designs being the best in fact.



You might be tempted to think that the three staple pro lenses in Nikon's lineup, the AF-S 14-24mm f/2.8G, the AF-S 24-70mm f/2.8G and the AF-S 70-200mm f/2.8G VR II would be safe bets, but you'd only be partly right. The aforementioned 70-200 is certainly spectacular, very sharp at virtually every focal length, however the other two lenses begin to show some weaknesses that were not apparent, or at least not as apparent, on previous lower megapixel Nikon bodies. For example, at some focal lengths, the extreme corners of the 14-24mm never really catch up to its excellent center sharpness, and the 24-70 is a bit weak at the long end, near 70mm. While both the 14-24 and 24-70 zooms are still quite useable on the D800, indeed still excellent for some types of shooting especially when stopped down, they are no longer the flawless performers they once seemed to be on a D3S or D700 for example.

The wider angle lenses that seem to do extremely well are as follows: the AF-S 24mm f/1.4G, the

brand-new AF-S 28mm f/1.8G, the AF-S 35mm f/1.4G, and the AF-S 16-35mm f/4G VR, as long as you shoot between 16 and 28mm. The 16-35 performs well in that range, even for corner sharpness, as long as it is stopped down above f/5.6, ideally to f/8 or better. In addition, I did some rigorous testing and it does not seem to suffer from any inconsistent VR-induced corner softness at all, which is something that I have noticed on some other stabilized wide-angle zoom lenses. After doing a bunch of research, there seem to be very few ultra-wide lenses that perform exceptionally well, corner to corner, on a D800. Even some highly regarded Carl Zeiss primes do not perform all that well until stopped down to the f/8 or f/11 range! Once you are over f/8, the Nikkor 16-35mm zoom seems pretty much on par with the best primes, better in some ways even from a colour consistency standpoint.

The 24mm and 35mm f/1.4G already perform quite well by f/5.6 (and are very sharp in the center even when nearly wide open), but even they need to be stopped down to about f/11 before the corners catch up to the center resolution if you are looking for an edge-to-edge, corner-tocorner tack sharp landscape shot. This is one of the reasons why I decided to get a regular D800 instead of a D800E: by the time you get much over f/8, the slight diffraction effects that already come into play more or less defeat any advantage the D800E might have as far as resolution. On the other hand, a lens as good as the 70-200 VR II, which reaches optimal sharpness by f/4 to f/5.6, well with that lens, you may indeed see some real resolution benefits on the D800E, presuming you can avoid moiré or other artifacts!

As far as 50 and 85mm primes, well pretty much any of the new AF-S 'G' full-frame lenses perform admirably well, as do the new Micro Nikkor 60mm and 105mm VR macro lenses.

Generally the super-tele primes are exceptional as well. Lastly, the brand new AF-S 24-85mm f/3.5-4.5G VR seems an excellent choice for a lightweight and sharp "walkaround" lens at under \$600, or for more range, you could get the AF-S 24-120mm f/4G VR zoom at just under \$1,300. However both those zooms will need to be stopped down somewhat before they perform up to snuff on the D800.

Olympus OMD E-M5 body in stock! - \$985



We now have the new weather-sealed 16 megapixel Olympus E-M5 in stock, which I'd say is the nicest overall Micro-4/3 body available at the moment. It sports an Olympus OM-inspired design, with a retro styled compact body, a builtin high-resolution EVF and an amazingly effective 5-axis internal sensor-based stabilization system. The benefit of the sensor-based stabilizer is that all lenses, whether Olympus, Panasonic or even adapted Leica lenses, for example, will gain image stabilization! It has by far the highest dynamic range of any Micro-4/3 body as well, with amazing highlight latitude that is on par with much higher-end DSLR systems. A first for Micro-4/3 cameras, one can also get a vertical battery grip for effortless portrait shooting, which also improves the handling ergonomics of the camera even holding it horizontally. Another innovative feature is "Live-Bulb" which will show you your time exposure as it slowly builds

up on the sensor. This is great for light-painting and also to avoid guesswork on nighttime city shots etc.

Panasonic GX1 body + LVF2 Viewfinder - Sale! \$589 + \$199 (regular \$699 + \$249)

Our Panasonic summer sale starts with the excellent and extremely compact 16 megapixel GX1 body. Although this body does not come with an EVF, like the E-M5, a very high quality one can be added. This offers the benefit of allowing the camera to be small when needed, but then if you want the more traditional "camera to the eye" shooting for stability and ease of framing in bright light, just slide on the viewfinder. An added bonus of the optional viewfinder is the ability to swivel it up 90 degrees for easier framing of low angle shots for example. Second only to the E-M5 for image quality, the GX1 has excellent dynamic range and is very clean in low light and high-ISO, on par with APS-C digital SLRs, especially when shooting raw. The GX1 has excellent ergonomics, numerous user-definable buttons for optimal setup to your shooting style, a remote socket to allow for time-lapse shooting and a built-in pop-up flash that can even be angled up for bounce flash photography. It is fully compatible with all Olympus and Panasonic Micro-4/3 lenses, as well us a huge slew of third-party adapters allowing you to use just about any legacy optics you might already have.

Additional rebates may also become available when an extra lens is purchased with the G1X!

TAP Packaging Solutions announced that they have discontinued manufacturing their Pin & Hinge (build-a-book) and Post Bound album covers, pages and mats, and that there will be changes to the way that many of their proof books will be supplied. These changes have been made to react to the needs of modern photographers and your clients, and to the innovations brought about by the digital age.

There have been no announced changes regarding their photo mounts or their digital albums.

Once my in-store proof books have been depleted, most will be available as components. You will be able to order your cover, choose what style of pages you would like to use, and decide whether to use catalogue/order form pages or not (although they do often prompt your client to order photos for people they might not have originally thought about, thereby increasing your profit margin).

I will be happy to provide either the TAP 'Big Bargain' style (acetate sleeves) or the Kangaroo brand (pocket pages). Both are 3-up 4x6 horizontal pages (so each page holds 6 photos). The BB pages are available in packages of 25 pages (150 photos) and the Kangaroo pages are available in packages of 10 pages (60 photos). Volume pricing is available. The only caution: Kangaroo does not make pages appropriate for use with 5x5 photos, so if you plan to present that

size, you will need to use TAP pages.

We've now sold out of the Fanfare 4x5 (24) Reversible Mat albums. These will now be available as 'special order only', items, so we will not be able to accept any returns on these unless defective.

AGT Photomount will be back to work on August 7th after their closure for staff vacations. I expect my next order to arrive at Beau Photo around the 18th of August.
