The Beau Bracket

Not many people nowadays know about the Beau Bracket, but at one time if there was one tool the wedding, portrait or event photographer would have had in their bag, that was it. The curious thing is that though this bracket is not. as widely known anymore, this tool is still as useful today as it was 15 years ago. So what is the Beau Bracket? It is arguably the best designed

and built flash bracket around. Not only does it get your flash off and over your camera to help eliminate background shadows, the flip arm allows the flash to be repositioned above the lens when you switch from horizontal to vertical orientation. It also positions the flash correctly so you do not get the light falloff on the top and bottom of your image that other conventional brackets cause.

The Beau Bracket was first designed back in the 90s by Beau Photo's owner Angie Apostolides. Several photographers approached Angie looking for a better flash bracket. Angie took their suggestions, designing and redesigning the bracket until it was perfected into a product he was finally satisfied with. The Beau Bracket became so popular that even Lisle Kelco, the Hasselblad distributor at the time, began purchasing Beau Bracket accessories from Angie to use with their bracket for Hasselblad photographers.

Various brackets have flooded the market over time, some were good, most were not, none have ever come close to the quality of the Beau Bracket. Perhaps this is the reason flash brackets have lost their appeal, as photographers have become dissatisfied with what's available and not knowing there is a better bracket out there. Other brackets have come and gone but the Beau Bracket is still around today, with quality and workmanship second to none, still

handmade, still Canadian made, still the best bracket for your money.

2014 Southwest Trip #2...

Well, I was off once again for a trip to the Southwest, this time in search of fall colours in Oregon, Nevada and Utah. I had some dodgy weather with interesting skies at the start, a few days of gorgeous weather with unbelievably crystal clear distant views and lastly, some amazingly warm but slightly hazy days too. Once again, I shot exclusively with my Fujifilm kit and used the Mindshift Rotation Panorama 180 camera bag as detailed in my article in our May 2014 newsletter. It all continued to perform admirably and after making some superbly sharp and detailed 24"x36" prints from my Fujifilm photos taken on my earlier trip this year, I decided that was all I would take on this trip once again as well. There is really not much else to add, other than my continuing satisfaction with the incredibly good Fujifilm lenses, the great colour and overall image quality of my X-E2 body and the excellent usability and quick access to that compact kit while hiking with my Mindshift camera bag.

The stars in my lens lineup were definitely the Fujifilm XF 14mm f/2.8 and XF 23mm f/1.4 primes, with especially the 23mm being one of the very best wide-angle lenses I have ever used. Incredible acutance, no distortion or chromatic aberration and flawless corner-to-corner sharpness. I have had customers mistake my 24"x36" prints of photos taken with that 23mm for ones taken with a medium format digital system! In addition, the 10-24mm ultra-wide zoom performed very well too. The inexpensive and lightweight 50-230mm zoom also surprised me again with its excellent sharpness - see below for a great rebate that's on right now!

Recently, PhotoNinja was updated as well, with the latest prerelease versions now giving even better image quality (especially when it comes to highlight recovery) from Fujifilm X-trans sensor raw files. I am looking forward to making some more big prints from my recent trip!

Fujifilm Rebates

Speaking of Fujiiflm, they have released bunch of new rebates for November. One thing I have spoken about often is how good their wide and tele conversions lenses are for the X100, X100S, and upcoming X100T of course. The wide conversion lens gives you a 28mm equivalent focal length and the tele will give you a 50mm equivalent. Optically, they are both exceptionally good and apart from a bit of distortion, there is essentially no loss of image quality. If shooting JPEGs, the distortion is automatically corrected for and most raw converters make short work of any corrections as well. For November, after the \$50 rebate, the wide-conversion lens is only \$299 and the tele conversion lens is only \$249. If you have an X100 series body and want more lens versatility, these two are definitely worth considering this month!

It is a very compact flash, powered by 2x AAA batteries and despite its size, offers a reasonably powerful guide number of 26. It will also tilt up or down for bounce flash or macro work, comes with a diffusion panel as well as a basic integrated video LED light, great if you want to do just a little bit of shadow fill, or just to create a catch light

in your subject's eyes. Obviously a single LED will be too hard a light source and not be bright enough to be used as a primary video light. Lastly, it also offers a flash slave mode. Don't stop shooting because of the rain!

All Weather Covers for Bags

It's that time of year again when almost every day there's a good chance it will rain, and as it gets colder maybe even snow. Whether you are taking a whole kit of gear to a shoot, going for a hike, working on your street photography skills or setting up for the long haul watching wildlife, it is imperative that your gear stays dry.

These days, the main purveyors of great camera bags almost all include a well-constructed rain cover for most of their rolling bags, backpacks, holsters and slings. **Think Tank** includes an all-weather cover with all of their bags. Most **LowePro** bags also include an all-weather cover, especially the new version of the Pro Roller 100 and 200 that we now carry, as well as the Transit Backpack, Hatchback, and the ProRunner. Their latest versions of the TopLoader Zoom AW II also include a cover. We now have a selection of bags from the new line by **Manfrotto** that include a great all-weather cover. The **MindShift** R 180 Panorama does



not include a rain cover with the bag, but we have them available for purchase separately.

All these bags are great for keeping your gear dry when it's not in use and you need to get from point A to point B.They

also help increase the security of your gear, keeping zippers and exterior pockets hidden to would-be pickpockets.

Hard Cases

If you want to go full-on water proof and completely sealed from terrible weather, we also carry **Pelican** and **Nanuk** hard cases! Even for your memory cards.

Rain Covers for your Camera

When you need to set up in the rain and still be able to shoot, there are still options for keeping your camera and lens dry. Many DSLRs these days are weather sealed, but it's nice to still try to keep them as dry as possible and generally nicer to work with dry equipment. We have two types of reusable, long lasting all weather covers available currently.

The very well built, high quality polyurethane/neoprene Think Tank version is the Hydrophobia and it comes in a couple of sizes. It has a clear window on the top, with bottom and side access sleeves to mount on a tripod and to reach in to operate the camera. The Hydrophobia cover requires an extra eyepiece depending on your DSLR, which helps to keep the cover in place and makes it easier to

operate the camera. It also includes its own external strap, so there is no need to detach the camera's strap or thread it through a hole in the cover. We regularly stock the 70-200mm version but can



also order in the 70-200mm with a flash version, or the longer 300-600mm version as well.

The slightly more inexpensive option is the KATA Elements Cover in small or medium. The small sized cover works well for a small DSLR with a shorter lens and the medium cover works with a longer

lens up to 200mm. Both sizes have a clear plastic viewing

hole at the top so you can still see your display, as well as zippered bottom if you are using the camera hand held and toggle ties on the sides to make the hand openings tighter.

If you don't generally shoot in inclement weather but would like to have a more disposable option on hand just in case, or know you are going to do a special shoot in a harsh location or are going on a holiday, we also have very inexpensive sleeves available. We have two kinds of plastic **OP/TECH Rainsleeves**, one that fits lenses with a diameter

up to 18" and another that fits lenses up to 14",





but has extra space to allow for a flash. They have a spot to fit over your eyepiece and a drawstring end to fit the sleeve snugly to your lens. Both come in packs of two.

also sealed on the edges, which adds nicely to the overall finished look and durability. The quality and craftsmanship of these straps is very well done. They come in a range of lengths and currently three colors: black, brown and cognac.

Each strap is hand made by award-winning photojournalist, Vancouver Sun and Province photographer, Jason Payne.

With years of experience in the field, Jason has really figured out what makes a great camera strap!

Lee Filters - New Slim Polariser

Lee Filters has announced a new polarizing filter that features a built-in warm-up effect. The IO5mm Landscape Polariser has been designed with a shallow mount and a IO5mm diameter. The filter not only removes glare from shiny surfaces it also increase the contrast between blue sky and white cloud, it can also enhance the greens, browns and golds in landscapes. The beauty of Lee filters is that the polariser will attach on the outside of the holder system allowing other filters to be used at the same time. Lee has yet to release a price in Canada so we will keep you updated.

While you wait for a polariser, check out the 100mm Lee Filters Foundation kit which is in stock and sells for \$149.95.

The Foundation Kit takes up to three standard 100mm filters at any one time. For instance you could combine Neutral Density and Warm-up Filters to respond to a specific lighting situation. The Foundation Kit clips onto the adapter ring which, in turn screws onto your camera's lens.

Impossible Project Round

Impossible Project's newest B&W 600 film, 'Round' frame has arrived, and I must say I am enamored with it. I even went so far as to lift it! It looks great. The emulsion they use is still square and the round mask isn't as light leak proof as one might hope, however it accents the outer square and the circle inside it.



I had been making circle shaped masks up until the Round frame came out, just to give my photos a different sort of look. To make the masks, I cut a circle out of an ND filter, and using a marker to colour the filter in to make it opaque and block light. I am in the process of trying different shapes other than a circle, but my shape cutting skills need to improve first!

Please don't be fooled by the Renaissance website that talks about "extensions to the deadline" as only American residents have the luxury of overnight shipping anywhere in the USA at a premium price."

Deadlines for delivery before Christmas vary depending upon manufacturer and the distance the products travel. Don't hesitate to touch base if you need help planning your timeline. If you discover that you need a large volume of product, please let me know as soon as possible.

If you plan to customize your presentation items (i.e. Boxes, Folders, Folios) and your die is on file at the manufacturer's, be aware that wait time in the imprinting queue is currently about 2 weeks so you will want to address that quite soon. If you need a die made up, send your artwork (black and white, camera-ready, sized correctly, no half tones or shading. EPS or Vector files preferred.) and I'll forward it to the factory Note: If your logo has multiple colours, each colour requires a separate die and strike.

I'll be placing my last TAP order for delivery before Christmas on November 26th. It's possible that orders received after that date might be here on time, but I can't recommend counting on it. If you've missed the deadline but your order absolutely, positively needs to be here, we can request expedited delivery for you. It adds a bit to your expenses, but your order would be here.

I'll be placing my last AGT order for delivery before Christmas on December 1st. Again, it's possible that orders received after that date might arrive before the big day, but expedited shipment might be required.




