#### **Argus Cameras**



Let me introduce you to one of the most used cameras of all time: the Argus C Series, an American standard, fondly referred to as "The Brick"! Argus sold around 3 million of its C series cameras over the span of three decades. From the 30s to the 60s they released many variations of the Argus: the C, C2 & C3 . This camera is so well loved that it has appeared in many films. It was used by the character Polly Perkins in one of my favorite movies *Sky Captain And The World Of Tomorrow*, and is also featured in the Harry Potter movies.

The Argus C series is an easy to use 35mm, manual focus rangefinder, fitted with a 50mm F3.5 lens that was noted for its surprisingly sharp photos. I think without the affordability of the Argus C cameras perhaps 35mm wouldn't have become so much more popular than 120 and 620 film sizes with amateur photographers. The C3 even has interchangeable lens options! It can be a little fiddly to swap them out but I bet that lens variety helped the C3 become the popular family holiday camera it did. Most common were the 100mm F4.5 telephoto and a 35mm F4.5 wide angle lenses. The C3 camera has a few other quirks in its

operation and I recommend reading the manual before you go out shooting. One such quirk, is that you have to push the tiny film catch knob located behind the film counter dial to get the film advance winder to release and film to start advancing. However, you are not meant to hold it down for more than the start of the turn as it might advance through two frames instead of the intended one frame. Easy to remember if you shoot only one camera but lets be honest, how many of us do that?! I guite enjoy shooting my Argus C3, I appriciate its evenly weighted body, surprisingly it doesn't drag on my shoulder like other cameras can, and the rangefinder has pretty good visibility. The only thing I found to be a problem (totally my fault), was that when I held the camera a certain way, the shutter cocking lever twanged back hitting my finger when I depressed the shutter release button. It is clearly shown in the Argus C3 operation manual that one needs to hold the camera in such a way that you aren't obstructing this lever.

We have various versions of the Argus C in our consignment department. There is an Argus C3 Fifth Variant in excellent condition for \$25.00. However I have a few fixer uppers here as well for \$6.00. If you were ever curious about how to clean mould from a camera lens and wanted to try it out, this would be the camera to do it on. In fact, if you wanted to practice minor repairs on a camera at all, there is a wonderfully informative article on the Argus collectors website about camera repairs.

#### The Kodak Brownie



Another popular family camera was the 127 sized Kodak Brownie Holiday Flash. Throughout the 50s Kodak made loads of these sweet little Bakelite charmers. However, it seemed to have had a shorter run than the Argus, probably due to the fact Kodak was pumping out many varieties of Brownie cameras left and right.

We have quite a few of these little Bakelite cameras for sale in the store now, and like many old cameras, they tend to come in showing their age. If you're like me, you may get caught on Pinterest for hours looking at cute cameras, and often the vintage cameras I see are all polished up and shiny. It got me thinking about how I'd go about polishing up my Bakelite cameras. So I Googled it. I learned that Bakelite was used because it didn't heat up excessively or conduct electricity. I also discovered, much to my surprise, it is made from a phenol and formaldehyde mix that often contained fillers such as wood, pulp, or any other powder material

waste that was available. So if you're curious if something actually is made of Bakelite you can try applying friction to its surface, and if it smells horrible like formaldehyde then presto its Bakelite and not plastic. I found that because so many vintage items are made of Bakelite there is still a Polish Paste NO.5 for Bakelite still available, however it seems to only be easily obtained in the UK. I ordered from a company called Greygate Chemicals Products Ltd. and it was only about \$12 including shipping. Paste No.5 is perfect because it is a polish and a wax in one. However there were many other cleaning suggestions online including using a metal polish such as Brasso, and afterwards use a bees wax polish for achieving a good shine.

If you're curious to try one, we have three Kodak Brownie Holiday Flash cameras on consignment for \$15 each.

#### The Lordomat Camera

I hadn't heard of the Lordomat, however upon getting one in on consignment I quickly became very interested. After delving into Google, I found everybody had the same things to say about it. It was the Leidolf Company that made the Lordomat camera. They started as a microscope lens manufacturer located in Weltzer,



Germany and in the 20s they began making cameras. That was short lived however, as they closed down sometime around 1962. The Lordomat model I have here was made in the 50s. I'm not usually a huge fan of rangefinders but that being said, I found this one extremely clear and I was able to focus it quickly. Using the Lordomat seems very straightforward, every dial has a obvious purpose, which isn't always the case with a lot of these old 35mm cameras. Its shutter speeds have quite a good range for an older camera, they are; 1, 2, 4, 8, 15, 30, 60, 125, 300. Its advance dial is pretty cute - it needs a double pump to advance the film fully, which is a little odd but there are few 35mm cameras that require this. This Lordomat has a 50mm F1.9 (through to F22) Leidolf Wetzlar Lordon Lens. This lens is interchangeable, however the mount isn't common. I took a photo of it as I have zero clue what it is officially called. It seems to lock in and then screw in.

#### New from Fujifilm

Another NEW and exciting item from Fujifilm is their latest Instax Share Printer, which retails for just \$239.99. The SP-2 prints wirelessly onto Fujifilm Instax Mini film,

connecting with smartphones, some Fujifilm digital cameras, and tablets. It also uses a wireless LAN that allows up to 8 users to connect at one time. The SP-2 has some great improvements over the original Share printer. Things such as improved image quality, faster printing speed, and a rechargeable battery with a micro USB charger make it worth having a look at. The app has also been improved to keep up with the SP-2. It now has collage options which lets you arrange more than one photo on a print.

However if you're looking for the best deal ever, the original Fuji Share Printer is selling for \$199, and then you also get a mail in rebate of \$40!

#### Kono Films

All five 35mm Kono films will soon be in stock at Beau Photo! Kono offers two tungsten films, the Kolorit 125T and the Kolorit 400T. They also have Rekorder, a 100 ISO B&W film. Kono offers two 'fun' films. My favorite is their very sweet Luft & Llebe, which is pre-exposed with a band of hearts. There is also the 400ISO Rotwild redscale film if you're feeling a little apocalyptic. Kono films are available for \$15.00 each.

#### **Guest Books**

Guest books or sign-in books are a great way for the guests to pass on their congratulations to the newlyweds during the celebration, and are another way for photographers to increase their income by simply printing engagement shots and producing an album. Here are Renaissance Albums' options for creating a guest book or sign-in book for your next photo event:

#### Essex Book (custom album)



The Essex Book is a 'spread design' album, providing full panoramic prints with square corners and thin pages. The paper is similar to the Fine Art and SoHo Book album paper but without the protective

coating or core mount between each page. It is important to purchase a fast drying permanent ink pen. The Essex book is a very popular choice for guest books with over 40 different cover options. Note: we need a lead time of about 4-6 weeks for delivery.

- Minimum 10 spreads to maximum of 35
- Fully customizable cover
- Full panoramic spreads, left hand start

#### Bowery Book (custom album)



The Bowery Book allows for high page capacity of up to 60 spreads with large scale prints. The structure of the paper allows pen or marker ink to absorb into the paper, making it a great choice for a guest book.
