Need new gear? The time to buy is NOW!

If you have any desire to buy camera gear any time soon, the time to buy is now! Due to exchange rate adjustments, we've already seen price hikes on lots of stuff, including Manfrotto, Hensel, Profoto etc., but starting April 1st, you also be seeing increases on Nikon and Sony and on April 16th, Fujifilm will also be raising prices. Canon has not given us any official notification yet, but word has it there will be price increases on April 1st as well. Not everything is going up, for example so far Sony has indicated that the A7 series of cameras are staying the same, but most Sony lenses will see an increase. Also, Nikon's new cameras, the D5 and D500, as well as the SB-5000 will not be going up, but other things will. For example the D810 will go up to a whopping \$3,999 starting April 1st, a \$500 increase!

Yet another great reason to buy now, is that many companies (other than Sony) are offering rebates just prior to all the price increases. As you'll see elsewhere in the our newsletter, Nikon will be having a Full-Frame Sales Event, Fujiiflm currently has rebates on until the end of March and Canon also has rebates. If you take the March savings into acount, then add on the coming price increases, you could easily save hundreds of dollars by deciding to buy now, rather than wait until later in the year!

Demo / Rental Digital Backs On Sale!

We need to free up some funds to upgrade our rental gear to the latest and greatest, so both of our Phase One systems are up for sale...

First up is our ex-rental **Phase One IQ140** with a 645 **DF body and 80mm leaf-shutter lens** offering flash-sync speeds up to a very fast 1/1600 second. The body has been upgraded with a 10K Li-lon battery pack and charger, giving you many thousands of frames between charges for the DF body. The IQ140 is a 40 megapixel digital back (1.3x crop-factor from 645) with an ISO range of 50-800, and in reduced resolution Sensor+ mode, up to ISO 3200. The



IQ140 is one of the newer generation of Phase One backs with a "Retina" resolution touch screen and a truly well designed and intuitive touch interface.

The IQ I 40 digital back with 645DF is a Value-Added bundle with all standard accessories and there is still roughly 6 months remaining on the factory warranty. The 645DF body and 80mm lens will have a 30 day warranty. The original plastic screen protector is still on the LCD so that should be pristine, but the body and back do have a few small nicks and scuffs as you can tell on the photo.

The price for this package is \$10,995. As an added bonus, we will throw in a \$500 rental coupon that you can use to rent or test out additional Phase One or Mamiya lenses, rent lighting etc...

Next, we have a **Phase One P65+ digital back on a Hasselblad H2 body**. This is a 60 megapixel, full-frame 645



CCD sensor digital back. It is a previous generation model, not having a touch screen, but it still offers truly superb image quality. It is an ideal camera for high-res studio shooting, whether it be product, fashion etc. To make the most of its resolution, it is paired with a Hasselblad H2 body, offering access to many exceptional lenses. This kit includes an HC 80mm lens and note that we currently have an excellent selection of used Hasselblad H lenses to choose from, all the way from a 28mm ultra-wide to a 150mm portrait lens too!

The price for this kit is \$9,995 and it will come with a 60 day warranty and also a \$500 rental coupon that can be used for anything in the Beau rental dept.

Fujifilm Updates

X-Pro2 bodies are imminent! Soon after you read this newsletter, we should have received our first shipment

of X-Pro2 bodies. Initial supply is somewhat limited but do know that anyone who has pre-ordered with us will be getting their camera promptly. I am hoping to receive



my own personal one too in early March. Once I've had a chance to shoot with a production body for a while, I will be posting a new blog review with updates on image quality, focus performance and more. I may be heading down to southern California in mid March since the desert has seen a fair bit of rain, and the conditions are looking promising for a fantastic wildflower bloom this year! That will be a perfect opportunity to throughly test out the new 24MP X-Pro2 with all of my Fujinon glass...

The new X-E2s kits (with 18-55mm) are in stock now as well. As mentioned in a previous newsletter, the X-E2s is only a very slight upgrade from the X-E2, which recently got a truly extraordinary v4.0 firmware update. In fact, with firmware v4.0 the older X-E2 is very nearly identical to the X-E2s and offers virtually all the functional improvements

of the X-T10, including far better video with more manual control, a totally revamped AF system with faster and more decisive acquiring of focus, decent focus tracking, face and eye detect,



group focus modes and more. You can now directly access the focus points using the rear "D-pad" and there are far more ways to customize the UI, including a programmable Q menu and more function button overrides. Playback of images has also been improved allowing for full-screen view, with a quick one-button, auto-resetting access to exposure data, histogram and overexposed highlight warning, alleviating the constant mashing of the DISP/BACK button while in playback, in order to flip through the various display modes. We still have a small number of X-E2 bodies in at a great price too (\$599 after rebate!), and with Firmware v4.0, remember that you are basically getting an X-E2s for \$300 less! I am working on a firmware v4.0 overview as well, destined for a future blog posting.

As of this writing, Canon has not finalized any info on a price increase, but unfortunately you can count on it happening too. Currently, there are some decent rebates that extend to March 3rd, so if you want anything act ASAP after reading this newsletter! There may be some new rebates later in March, but no word on those yet.

NEW! Canon EOS-80D Body (\$1,599 - April delivery)

Canon has announced the **EOS-80D** as a successor to the **EOS-70D** and it seems to be a very substantial upgrade! Without having handled one, I cannot comment on it in detail, but here are some of the key improvements...

- new 24.2 megapixel CMOS sensor with full-coverage Dual-Pixel AF
- new wider, 45 point AF system, all cross sensors, many sensitive to f/8
- improved Dual-Pixel AF for live-view stills and video, with much quicker and more decisive tracking
- 7560 pixel RGB+IR metering sensor that also assists with focus tracking
- 100% viewfinder coverage
- 7 fps shooting, light source flicker reduction
- enhanced video with 1080p/60, ALL-I or IPB modes and optional embedded time-code
- intelligently positioned HDMI, mic and headphone jacks that don't interfere with the rear tilt/swivel touch-screen LCD
- adjustable speeds for Movie-Servo-AF to allow faster or smoother tracking of moving subjects
- enhanced weather and dust seals in the body

All in all, a very solid upgrade to Canon's prosumer line of EOS digital bodies!

A bundle with the new 80D and this lens is available for \$2,399. An intriguing Power-Zoom accessory for this new kit lens is





also available for \$215. It clips on to the bottom of the lens and allows for variable speed power zooming, an extremely useful feature to have while filming video. Having a separate adapter is a great idea since if you don't need power-zoom, you are not paying extra, nor are you having to deal with the additional bulk permanently added to the lens.

Lastly, Canon has also announced the new DM-EI Directional Stereo Microphone (\$369) accessory. All these new products should be available some time in April.

For stills, it is also fast, shooting at up to 11 fps or 8fps with full EVF live tracking. The new high-res EVF is fast too, with a smooth and lag-free 120 fps refresh and minimal shot-to-shot blackout. A stronger magnesium alloy body, with enhanced dust and moisture resistance, makes for a more durable and reliable camera as well.

Sony has also announced three new high-end professional full-frame 'G Master' lenses for their mirrorless E-mount. perfect for the new high-res A7R Mark II for example. There are two important new pro series zooms, the FE 24-70mm f/2.8 GM (\$2,899 - late March) and the FE 70-200mm f/2.8 GM OSS (ETA and price TBA), as well as a fast portrait prime, the FE 85mm f/I.4 GM (\$2,399 - late March). Ultra-minature and Sub-miniature Cameras

These are a type of small camera that take film smaller or narrower than 35mm. 35mm cameras were originally referred to as miniature cameras as they were smaller than the standard 120 size film.

Ultra-minature and sub-minature camera film sizes include 16mm, 17.5mm, 110, 127 and many more. Some of the better known ultraminiature and subminiature cameras are Minox, Tessina, Coronet Midget, Sakura Petal, Steky,



and Foth Derby.
There are many
manufacturers of
these little cameras.



Two of the cutest and most common Japanese ultramini cameras are the 'Hit' camera and the 'Mycro' camera. These were made from the 1930s to the 1950s. When the Hit was new, it sold for about .52 cents. The Hit was the more automatic of the two with a set aperture, and shutter speeds B & I . The Mycro has a surprising amount of adjustment with shutter speeds of 25, 50, 100, and Bulb, and with apertures of 4.5, 5.6, 8 and 11. It has a 20mm lens. The teeny tiny 17.5mm film takes ten 14×14mm frames.

I was lucky enough to get my hands on a Mycro with

original film in it! Kathy and I decided I should shoot it and then process it. 17.5mm is significantly smaller than any developing reel we have here so Kathy decided to use a juice bottle that she cut a hole in, then pushed the developing tank column through the hole so the









bottle would sit correctly in the developing tank. In a dark bag she wrapped the film around the bottle emulsion side out and taped it. The film was extremely curly from being trapped in the camera so long. We processed it in Blazinal I/25 for 6 minutes. After being processed, it became apparent the film was indeed fogged from age. The frames I shot, though fogged and under-exposed, still made me happy, I got somewhat recognizable images! Sadly the first frames that had been shot long before I got the camera had no image on them anymore.

A good customer of ours mentioned to me when he processes the smaller odd sized roll films he will use a already processed uncut regular sized emulsion such as 35mm or 120 to attach the smaller sized film too, emulsion side out. Then it can still be loaded into a standard reel.

Some ultra and submini cameras were used in "Pigeon Photography" in the early 1900s. Julius Neubronner, a gentleman living in Germany, conceived of this idea and was

granted a patent in 1908 for a light weight time delayed miniature camera to be mounted to an aluminum breast harness which was worn by his homing pigeons. His pigeons, who were already being used for pigeon post deliveries, were specially trained to carry the extra weight. Some have said that these pigeons were the "worlds first drones". The images were used for military purposes, as well as to make postcards that were sold to the public.

New Consignment Cameras

A neat TLR **Argus Argoflex** has come into the consignment department. Argus manufactured this 120 film model in the 40's. Aside from the ruby window needing a little repair, this camera is in excellent condition.

In the 30s, Argus started manufacturing cameras. Before this

they had only been producing bakelite radio sets. This was the start of many different Argus camera varieties. A lot of people like to collect Argus cameras, so much so that there's an 'Argus day' for Argus enthusiasts to share photos. It usually takes place mid 'Argust' each year.

The Ilford Sportsman Vario made in Western Germany in the 60s is another favourite of mine. It takes 35mm film and inside the back door there is a sticker instructing the shooter to "always use ILFORD 35mm FILMS, Ilfachrome for colour". Another interesting piece of unique history in this camera is that the original owners put a neat little sticker in it that reads 'Westminster Photographic 81

strand W.C.2.'That is an address in London! This camera looks good, and I adore its ISO film dial. It reads 'Ilford film' then its ISO settings read PanF, D Colour F, HP3, FP3, instead of the standard 50, 100, 400, 500 etc.



The shutter button is conveniently located for a right handed person, beside the lens barrel and perfectly placed for one's index finger to push.



The Sportsman has good aperture range, 2.8, 4, 5.6, 8, 11, 16, and 22. Its shutter speeds are 200, 50, 25 and B. Unfortunately this camera has no internal light meter. The 45mm lens uses

a focusing scale from 31/3 feet to infinity. This Sportsman comes with a leather case and is selling on consignment for \$55.00


