

The Beau Bracket - Still the best around.

The Beau Bracket was first designed back in the 90s by Beau Photo's owner Angie Apostolides. Several photographers approached Angie looking for a better flash bracket. He took their suggestions, designing and redesigning the bracket until it was perfected into a

product he was finally satisfied with. The Beau Bracket became so popular that even Lisle Kelco, the Hasselblad distributor at the time, began purchasing Beau Bracket accessories from Angie to use with their bracket for Hasselblad photographers. Various brackets have flooded the market over time, some were good, most were not, none have ever come close to the quality of the Beau Bracket. Sony A7RIII in Rentals

I have been playing with the various video features of the recently released Sony A7RIII body, and I have been quite impressed with the quality of the camera. The 4K video is impressive, and of course, the full HD 1080p quality is fantastic. The focus of this little article is my experience with the A7RIII and its high speed frame rates that allowed me to shoot slow motion video of a few local hummingbirds and their nests. I had the privilege of observing three very accessible hummingbird nests this year, which I did from far enough away so as not to stress the mother. This video is one minute long and shows a female Anna's Hummingbird feeding her babies in her nest. Hummingbirds feed their young a mixture of small insects, pollen and nectar, which is partially digested and regurgitated through their beaks into the gullets of the young. In this video you can see the slurry transferring from mother to baby, something which is invisible to the naked eye in real time.

This second video is in real time, just to show what can be seen utilizing the slow motion capabilities of the Sony A7RIII. https://youtu.be/dhKwKmpB8CU

Used Close-Up Filters

Nicole has done a great job here at Beau reorganizing the used analogue department and preparing everything for our big move when the day comes. This included a total revamp of the hoards of used filters. They are now all nicely separated into their different types or uses, hopefully making them much easier to sift through. After all of this organization, there seems to be an abundance of close-up filter sets and singles.



Close-up filters, or more accurately, close-up LENSES, work essentially like a magnifying glass for your lens. They are great if you want to add a bit of magnification to your lens without spending the big dollars on a macro lens, though it is important to note

that they act a bit differently. As they are in fact just close-up lenses, they can't be used to shoot at just any focal length, they only work to allow your regular lens to focus more closely than it would normally. While a true macro lens will certainly give you some added sharpness, close-up lenses are great for many photo adventures or artistic endeavours. Now that it is finally spring and the blossoms are popping out, it is a great time to try out these lenses! They are available in various strengths and can be stacked to gain even more magnification.

We've got quite the range of used close-up lenses for very reasonable prices, in both singles and sets. Most are in smaller filter sizes, as they were more commonly used on film cameras, such as 49mm, 55mm, or 58mm.



In 1971 the Bolex H16 EBM Electric was marketed as being exceptionally sturdy and reliable. While reading its ad pamphlet I was almost sold on its cutting edge 1971 technology. They really seemed to put a lot of consideration

into its function and design. Listed in the brochure are 8 of the hottest selling points:

- I Its built-in electric motor transports the film at electronically stabilized speeds.
- 2 It is designed for sync sound recording; choice of two systems; crystal synchronization of sync pulse synchronization with automatic slating.
- 3 It can be fitted with the Vario-Switar 100 POE lens with built-in light meter for automatic setting of the aperture during filming, as well as with a diaphragm presetting device for viewing with the diaphragm fully open between two takes.
- 4 Designed for 100ft spools of film, it can also take accessory magazines for 200 ft spools or rolls on cores up to 400ft.
- 5 Its ultra-resistant, foolproof bayonet lens-mount makes lens changing extremely rapid.
- 6 Its luminous reflex viewfinder with a high power of magnification (14x) allows perfect viewing under ideal conditions.



- 7 It threads automatically and in a matter of seconds.
- 8 Although light, compact and extremely handy, it is a very sturdy and reliable camera designed specifically for professional use.

The Polaroid 600SE rental is only \$25 per day/weekend, and the film prices range from \$55-\$85.00 per pack depending on whether its the Fuji FP100c or the Fuji FP3000b.

Creative Darkroom Printing With Your Cellphone.

Nicola and her students from Vernon Secondary School have managed the perfect mix of analogue and digital in the darkroom. Here's how:

- I. Find a picture you want to work with and import it in PIXLR. Use the monochrome filter and adjust brightness/contrast.
- 2. Turn off cellphone screen saver, put it on airplane mode and turn brightness display all the way up.
- 3. Now you are ready to enter the darkroom.
- 4. Put paper and test strips in a drawer or bag. Make sure you have an easel and two pieces of cardstock ready.

- 5. Put the cardstock in the slot in front of the bulb on the enlarger. Put cell phone in the enlarger where the negative goes. Turn on and select picture. Let others in the darkroom know that you are doing this so you do not interfere with their developing. Adjust the head of the enlarger until the image is the correct size.
- 6. Place paper on the easel.
- 7. Make a test print strip by placing a strip of paper down in the image area, and moving card stock back every two seconds.
- 8. Develop the test strip. Once you have determined which timing works from your test strip, place paper on the easel and turn your phone on for the desired length of time.
- 9. Develop your print!

It usually arrives late September or mid October sometime.



New Orders

I'm only sending orders to our U.S. based suppliers quarterly now, so I've been contacting the clients who traditionally have projects using these manufacturer's products in that time frame. Barring emergencies, I anticipate my next Tyndell and TAP orders will be placed in mid-May for delivery in early June, followed by my fall order in early September.

I'll be contacting you shortly about ordering for June/July/ August. If you'll have projects to present during this time, please contact me so I can add you to my follow up list if you're not already on it!

Please note that when ordering imprinted mounts from TAP and Tyndell, you will need to allow additional lead time.

With AGT being in Canada, we can order more easily since we don't have to worry about brokerage charges, uncertainties about NAFTA, the vagaries of the U.S. dollar, etc. As a bonus, AGT typically uses better quality cardstock than their U.S. counterparts (often at better prices), so many of our clients have moved to AGT products to save time and \$\$.

AGT is also my factory of choice when it comes to imprinting. From the creation of a die to completion of your imprinted mounts usually takes about 7-10 working days (their U.S. counterparts usually require that much time for creation of the die only, with another 5-15 days in the imprinting queue).

Their standard foil colours are black, gold and silver. Other colours may be available but might cost a bit more. Mounts can be ordered in black, brown, soft grey outside with matte white inside, and 'pure white' (glossy white outside, matte white inside).

If you are just starting out shooting video on your DSLR camera or more advanced and looking to explore how to move the camera creatively for capturing motion, this hands on day with professional dancers will force you to move the camera and get it off the tripod.
