NEW! Nikon Zf in Silver

Nikon has announced a new silver body for the retro styled Zf. As many of you already know from my reviews, I do love a silver retro-designed camera and this new Zf looks gorgeous! It can also be special ordered in a number of different leatherette cladding covers in different colours. The pricing is exactly the



same as the regular all black one (\$2,999) and should be shipping once you read this. Note however that for now, the silver Zf (even the regular black-clad one) will be special order only, unless it proves popular against the all black model.

NEW! Nikon ZR Cinema Focused Mirrorless Body



Nikon has announced their first major product in partnership with RED, whom they bought early in 2024. The Nikon ZR is a cinema focused full-frame mirrorless camera with a partially-stacked 24.5MP CMOS sensor, which it inherits from the Z6 III. It will be shipping in October for \$2,999. If you are looking for an affordable, dedicated full-frame cinema camera, this Nikon looks to be one of the top contenders, if not the top, especially at its price point. There are many substantial changes to not only its user interface (compared to regular Nikon Z system cameras), but also to its hardware (as compared to a Z6III) in order to make it a much better cinema option. As far as hardware upgrades, it has an extra bright 4" rear LCD with DCI-P3 colour-space, which is apparently bright enough to be used in direct sunlight. That's a good thing too, since this camera lacks an EVF. Being a dedicated video tool, it also lacks a mechanical shutter, so there will be some compromises when trying to use it for shooting stills, which it absolutely can do if needed though, with essentially of the still photo features of the Z6 II. The new ZR achieves efficient heat dissipation without the use of fans, with the entire body



The ZR also has internal 32 bit floating point audio recording for the highest possible dynamic range and flexible audio processing

in post. It records in many different modes, including 6K/60p in 12-bit R3D NE raw video with 15+ stops of dynamic range in REDWideGamutRGB colour space. It

terms of slow-motion, it can record in 4K at 119.88p and at Full HD at 239.76p. If you are a video professional (which I am not), you will surely glean more info from the links provided above. We are taking pre-orders for this new camera now!

NEW! Fujifilm GFX Eterna 55 Cinema Camera

Fujifilm also has an upcoming cinema camera that is under development, the medium format GFX Eterna 55. Canadian pricing is not yet nailed down, nor delivery date, although expect the body to be over \$20,000.



It too will be a dedicated, video focused cinema camera with an internal variable ND filter and a body design that lends itself to use with video rigs. It will take GF mount lenses natively, but will also include an advanced PL mount adapter with lens communication features

NEW Kentmere Pan 200 Film



Kentmere Pan 200 is a black and white film introduced in 2025 by Harman, the makers of llford, created a budget friendly versatile option for photographers.

Kentmere 200 is rated at ISO 200 and features medium, fine grain which I find to be smoother

than Kentmere 400 but slightly more pronounced than Kentmere 100. It offers good sharpness, though not as crisp as a premium film like Ilford Delta or Kodak T-Max. It has nice contrast compared to Kentmere 100 and 400, delivering deeper blacks and brighter whites while keeping details in highlights and shadows. It handles high contrast scenes well but can show a slight bloomy glow in the highlights, especially with certain lenses. I find that this film is forgiving with exposure, making it scanner friendly due to a flatter contrast curve. It performs best in well lit or contrasty conditions but may struggle in harsh sunlight unless metered correctly.

Kentmere 200 strikes a balance, offering finer gain than 400 and high contrast than both, making it the standout in the Kentmere lineup for many photographers. The film is a good choice for photographers seeking an affordable, high contrast black and white film with solid performance across diverse conditions. Its medium grain and forgiving nature make it ideal for beginners and those shooting frequently without breaking the bank. While it doesn't rival premium films, its value and versatility earn it high praise as a daily film stock. I find it to be my favourite out of the Kentmere line.

Camp Snap CS-8 Digital Video Camera

Lots of you have loved the Camp Snap screen free digital camera lately, so you'll be excited to know that we just got their new Super 8 style digital video camera in stock! The CS-8 is the newest release from Camp Snap and was



designed to look almost identical to vintage Super 8 cameras, but without the hassle and price of Super 8 film (and it records audio!).



Its user interface is very similar to the Camp Snap Screen Free Digital Camera with no playback screen, designed to keep you in the moment when taking pictures or filming. The CS-8 has a very simple design, the only controls are a trigger to start and stop filming and three dials: on/off, aspect ratio, and preset filters. The aspect ratio options it comes with are 9:16 (made for Instagram and TikTok), 1:1, 16:9, and 4:3, giving you a pretty good

range to choose from. It also comes with five pre-installed filters, Standard (STD), Vintage 1 (VTG1), Vintage 2 (VTG2), Analog (ANA), and Black & White.

Each press of the trigger on the front of the camera records one clip, and stops filming when you let go. There is a viewfinder through the eyepiece to see what you are filming, but you won't be able to replay the clips until you import the footage. It comes with a 4GB SD card installed which holds 30 minutes of recording time, and can support up to a 128GB SD card for 16 hours of recording time. It also comes with a USB-C to USB-C cable to import the clips directly onto a phone or computer, and it also doubles as the charging cable.

I've had a great time playing around with this camera and think it's a super fun way



to capture some in-the-moment vintagestyle video. It is perfect for filming behind the scenes footage, ideal for social media videos. We have the CS-8 available in store and online for \$225.

Tenba Bags

Each season, we look forward to boosting our inventory, even in the most subtle ways. While this isn't a major announcement, it's worth mentioning, judging by the sheer number of pointand-shoot cameras we sell every week.



Many of our customers often ask if we have a bag that's a good choice for these compact cameras, typically no more than five inches in length.

Tenba, one of our favourite brands, has released the Tenba Skyline Pouch v2 in two sizes, and one of them would make an excellent addition to any point-and-shoot camera purchase.

The Tenba Skyline Pouch v2 4 measures 3.25W x 5.5H x 2.75D inches, making it a perfect fit for a camera like the Fuji X100 VI.

The Tenba Skyline Pouch v2 3 measures 3W x 4.75H x 2D inches, which is more suitable for cameras like the Olympus Mju II or the Olympus XA2.

These pouches can be tucked into your backpack or worn standalone using the included shoulder strap. Both are made from durable 300D polyester fabric and



feature YKK zippers—some of the most highly regarded in the industry. These small details



are crucial, especially when you're taking your first film camera out into the field. You'll want to protect it from the elements, and the Tenba Skyline Pouch will do an excellent job of that.

The Olympus Trip 35

Olympus Trip 35, a cute lightweight (for not being a plastic camera) automatic gem! Just as the name suggests, these little beauties take your standard 35mm film. They are fully automatic cameras, the ISO of the film being the only thing you need to set. If you put the same ISO film in every time, you needn't ever change it again after the first time.

A few specs on the camera: it has a 40mm 2.8 lens, has a shutter speed range of 1/40 to 1/200, and has a hot shoe for flash! How handy is that! The Trip 35 came with a solar powered selenium cell and a shocking amount of them still work today.

Two of the Trip 35's we have here for sale have been film tested and two have only been eye-balled, this is reflected in their price and still need a roll run through them to be sure of optimal functionality. Never fear, this is why we here at Beau Photo offer a 30 money back guarantee for such things as selenium cells that have mislead us in to believing they are reading correctly.

Rolleicord Magic II



Personally I love the stoic look of this Rollei. It not only looks a bit different, but functions a bit differently than the other 'flex's and 'cord's. It lacks the focus knob of its brethren, instead it uses a charming little wheel on its face (on a flex this would control the aperture) and then its other wheel controls both the aperture and shutter speeds coupled or independently from one another.

A few specs on the camera:

- uses 120 type film
- 75mm f3.5 lens
- has a shutter speed range of 1/30 to 1/500 and bulb mode.




Photo Walk, Artist's Talk and Exhibition Tour Event October 11th • Noon - 2:30ish • Gallery 881
